PROJECT UPDATE

The Inquiry and Advisory Committee (IAC) Panel Hearing for the Goschen Project was completed on Tuesday 30 April 2024. Throughout the six-week period the Panel heard from a number of expert witnesses and submitters who presented in person in Melbourne, Swan Hill, and online. Based on expert evidence heard and submissions made, the IAC has 40 business days to compile a report about the Project's environmental effects and submit to the Minister for Planning. The timing of the Minister's assessment of the Goschen Project Environment Effects Statement (EES) is at her discretion.

The Goschen Project will provide approximately 400 jobs for the region during the 20+ year life of the mine and will inject millions of dollars into the Loddon-Mallee economy every year.

In recent weeks I have continued my commitment to engage directly with the local community and also met with the Board of the Murray Mallee Local Learning and Employment Network (MMLLEN), Member for Murray Plains Peter Walsh and the Murray Plains Electorate Support Group, to provide an update on the status of the Project and answer any questions they had. I was pleased to receive positive community feedback in support of the Project, and the economic diversification and opportunities that it will bring to the region.

As part of our commitment to supporting the community, we proudly continue our sponsorship of the Central Rivers Football-Netball League (CMFNL) and this year VHM has extended this sponsorship support to encompass the CMFNL Under 12 Boys football and the AFL Central Vic/CMFNL Junior Girls competition.

Institution of Surveyors Victoria Swan Hill Regional Conference

As a key regional destination, Swan Hill hosted The Institution of Surveyors Victoria annual conference on 27 April and VHM was invited to speak at the conference about the Goschen Project. Vesna Rendulic presented to the 75-strong audience who hailed from across Victoria and took great interest in the Project with a number of questions following the presentation.



Surveying plays a critical role in all phases of mining by providing accurate spatial data to inform decision-making – from aerial surveys during the mineral exploration phase, through to measuring and mapping physical features of land prior to disturbance; ascertaining boundaries, measurements and maps for mine site planning, design and construction; helping to determine location of utilities, roads and other infrastructure; as-built survey after construction to verify adherence to plans and specifications; confirming volumes of material mined and processed; and recording the area of rehabilitated land each year.
